**Duration:** 1-1.5 Hours

From there the pilot will begin the inflation process, giving you the opportunity to become an involved, "hands on" crew member as the gentle giants come to life. You may also choose to observe inflation and take pictures as the sun rises over the hills of the Sonoran Desert.

At lift off you'll embark upon a journey of uniqueness. Enjoy breathtaking views of the Sonoran Desert while floating across the sky. Send your greetings to the earthbound folks below! Breakfast and Dinner available.

## **PRIVATE HOT AIR BALLOON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP**

**Duration:** Varies

A photography class and a flight in one! Fly with a professional photographer who will provide individualized instruction at your pace. You'll have a chance to capture the balloon's initial inflation, and enjoy the luxury of extra space in the basket once aloft to capture stunning panoramas from above.

## **SKYLINE TOUR**

**Duration:** 12-15 Minutes

Sedona is all about the skylines. Towering spires jut spectacularly into the open sky in every direction you look. On the Skyline tour, we soar south off the airport mesa to view the incredible Cathedral Rock, then on towards the famous Bell Rock and Courthouse Butte. Turning north towards the Chapel of the Holy Cross, we wave "hello" to Snoopy Rock as we cross over Oak Creek Canyon making our way back to the airport mesa.

### **GUIDED RAFTING TOUR**

**Duration: 4 Hours**

Experience the Sonoran Desert and explore one of its rarest ecosystems. The river corridor is home to over three quarters of all the plant and animal species in the Southwest. Knowledgeable guides will share their insights into this amazing environment, along with providing instruction, encouragement and supervision to all tour participants. Each excursion is curated to the guests interests and abilities.

### **RIVER RODEO**

**Duration: 4.5-5 Hours**

Team River Rafting Rodeo combines a classic river tour with a series of fun and exciting competitive events. After a safety briefing and paddle instructions, participants will launch into Class 1 ( easy segment) of the river. Next, let the games begin! As participants float the last three miles of the river, teams encounter river based and shore based challenges that require teamwork, communication and strategic thinking. From Blind Navigation to the Bucking Bronco these challenges are fun, exciting and sure to create a splash!

### **GUIDED KAYAKING OR PADDLE BOARD TOUR**

**Duration: 1.5-2.5 Hours**

Arizona is an amazing place to kayak. The dramatic contrast between desert & water is rather unexpected. Because water is the most valuable resource in a desert, it's not uncommon to see wild animals along the banks of the rivers. This smooth-water float is a great opportunity to see wildlife in their native habitat and appreciate the beauty of our natural environment. We offer river or lake options.

The Salt River is a Class I river (the easiest rating on the international scale of river difficulty) and provides some of the best wildlife and bird watching opportunities in the Southwest. Water temperatures are in the 60s in the winter and rise to low 80s in the summer months. Swimming is possible year-round, but the water may be chilly in January! Tours take place on Saguaro lake, Lower Salt or Verde Rivers.

## ARIZONA FISHING TRIPS

**Duration: Half Day & Full Day**

Fishing in the desert? Yes, it's real and really fun! With six incredible lakes to choose from, and species ranging from Largemouth Bass to Stripers, from Small Bass to White Bass, there is a fishery perfectly suited for every condition, season, and skill level and your Arizona fishing guide will know all the best spots.

Lakes include Lake Pleasant, Roosevelt Lake, Bartlett Lake, Saguaro Lake, Apache Lake, and Canyon Lake. These destinations are some of the premier bass waters in the Southwest, and some are just minutes from Phoenix/Scottsdale.

You'll be outfitted with high performance gear such as G.Loomis rods, Shimano reels, and all the bait & gear necessary to have fun on Arizona's premier lakes.

## BIKE N'HIKE AT PAPAGO PARK

**Duration: 1.5-2 Hours**

Enjoy an adventure into the scenic Papago Park made up of volcanic rock formations, lagoons, palm trees and cactus. Spend time hiking on top of the Papago Buttes and iconic "Hole in the Rock" for amazing views of downtown Phoenix and Tempe.

**Duration: 1.5 hours**

Enjoy a lazy e-bike ride through Old Town and discover why Scottsdale is the "West's Most Western Town." Meander through the streets of Old Town Scottsdale where horses and buggies traveled not so long ago. Now, the streets are filled with plenty of specialty shops, art galleries, and unique restaurants. You'll pass through the new Scottsdale Waterfront and Scottsdale Civic Center, along the way learning about Scottsdale's history dating back to the late 1800s.

## ROAD BIKING

Our guided road biking tours in Scottsdale and the Phoenix metro area are led by experienced professional guides and tailored to each guest. Our guides know the best cycling routes in Phoenix and Scottsdale, offering lengths from 15-100 miles. These guided road bike tours are perfect for the avid cyclist, the visiting triathlete in training, or the casual road biker.

All equipment is high-performance and set up to fit right; high performance & elite upgrades available on request for an additional fee, depending on the bike. Let us know your pedal requirements and the sort of ride you are looking for and we will design it for you. If you have pedals of your own, feel free to bring them with you. Guided road rides can be arranged to suit varying skill levels and molded to challenge each individual.



### **DESSERT HUMMER TOUR**

**Duration: Half Day**

The H-1 Hummer is arguably one of the most advanced and rugged 4x4 vehicles on the planet. Used by the US Military, these off-road beasts can navigate terrain that no other vehicle can. And they'll prove it! Strap in, hold on and let's roll! In a Hummer you'll be able to get further into the desert and see things inaccessible to the average day-adventurer. Immerse yourself in the splendor of the Sonoran Desert with professional guides and the most up-to-date equipment. Depending on the tour, you could see Indian ruins, ghost towns, mountain tops, or you can see what the Hummer can REALLY do.

Or, come experience the Sonoran Desert in a Chevy M1009 Blazer. The M1009 (that's M-10-oh-9) is a military-style Blazer with a diesel V8 engine so powerful it'll knock your socks off. But here's the catch: these tricked-out rides feature the best shocks available, so you'll be riding in style and in comfort. The power of the engine combined with the military-grade rear Gov-Lock system lets adventurers on the M1009 tour explore even rocky, steep trails without breaking a sweat.

### **ATV & UTV TOURS**

**Duration: Half Day**

Immerse yourself in the history of this forbidden frontier. Discover the abundant flora and fauna which inhabit the Tonto National Forest. Experience the thrill of navigating through 20-25 miles of seasonal creeks, sandy washes, rocky riverbeds, and rugged desert trails.

Visit the most serene mountains and lakes the Sonoran Desert has to offer within 30 square miles of riding area equipped with marked trails.

### **JEEP TOURS**

**Duration: Half Day**

No matter where you go, one of the best ways to explore the area is by 4x4 Jeep. The Sonoran Desert is no exception. Buckle in and get ready to experience the ruggedness of this amazing landscape. Your guides are trained naturalists that will show you all there is to offer. ## PHOENIX HIKE

**Duration:** Half Day

The Sonoran Desert offers a stunning variety of plants and cacti, critters and history. Hiking is the best way to explore this unique landscape. The Valley is home to no less than four beautiful, world class desert parks, each with an elaborate network of excellent trails. Enjoy a tour catered to your desires - be it fitness, photography, nature walks or something in between.

## WILDFLOWER HIKE

**Duration:** Half Day

The saying goes "April showers bring May flowers". However, here in the Sonoran Desert the saying should be "if it rains in December, the wildflowers you'll remember" . . . or something along those lines. Our wildflower season begins in February and is in full swing through May. Around mid-February you'll see a green blanket start to cover the desert floor; by the end of the month it looks like Walt Disney came through with a paint brush.

## SONORAN TREKKING

**Duration:** Full Day

The Sonoran Desert is a biological wonderland. Home to 60 species of mammal, more than 350 kinds of birds, 20 amphibians, around 100 reptiles and over 2000 native species of plants this playground is surprisingly green. Let our expert guides tailor a hike for you. Not only will you experience the most biodiverse desert in the world but the views are usually spectacular.

Our full day Phoenix & Scottsdale hiking tours give us plenty of time to really immerse ourselves in the landscape. ## **HORSEBACK RIDING**

**Duration: 1 or 2 Hours**

Wanna be a cowboy? Come along on the quintessential Arizona adventure - a classic trail ride! Seeing Arizona's spectacular desert scenery from the back of a horse gives you a taste of the Old West. Imagine riding trails that have been used for hundreds of years by lawmen, outlaws, indians and settlers.

Feel the towering saguaro cactus gazing upon you as we tell the colorful history of lost gold mines and the mysteries of the Sonoran Desert. Learn about the wild west and what makes this landscape special.

## **SONORAN DESERT SHOOTING ADVENTURE**

**Duration: 1 Hour**

Enjoy the picturesque Sonoran desert as you learn basic shooting skills from our NRA Certified Range Safety Officer. Once we arrive at our designated outdoor shooting site, our experienced instructors will provide everything you need for a safe and educational shooting activity. The shooting experience begins with an in-depth Firearm Safety Debriefing. Next, each shooter will fire a full 17 Round Magazine from a Glock 9MM Handgun. To top off the experience, each outdoor shooter will fire one 30 Round Magazine from the infamous AK-47 Semi-Automatic Assault Rifle!



## **SEGWAY TOUR**

**Duration: 2 Hours**

Discover the beauty of the Arizona desert while riding a Segway through Old Town Scottsdale, or explore the jewel of Tempe Town Lake.

Guided, narrated tours allow you to learn the history and see the beautiful sights of the Phoenix area while mastering the Segway, the world's only self balancing personal transporter!

## **APACHE TRAIL TOUR**

**Duration: Full Day**

Hop aboard a custom touring van for an unforgettable trip back in time along the Apache Trail, one of Arizona's scenic byways. Only minutes from the city, the Apache Trail is a true wilderness adventure and a perfect day in the Sonoran desert. Arizona's first designated "Historic Highway", this breathtaking road got its start as an Indian route. It eventually became the supply route for one of the first reclamation projects in the U.S., now a system of four desert lakes, the largest being formed by Roosevelt Dam at the end of the trail.

This full day tour takes you to through some of the most dramatic landscapes on the planet. You'll visit Goldfield Ghost Town, Tortilla Flats (a historic stagecoach stop) and take a cruise on the Dolly Steamboat at Canyon Lake.




Our setup is completely off-the grid and our venues vary from the desert & forest wilderness to golf course and farm dinners.
